



Olliegraphic Printable Card: Directions & Tips

Supplies

All you need is a printer and paper! That said, the quality of paper will greatly affect the outcome of your card. Heavyweight card stock (90 to 110 lb) in white is ideal. Card stock is available online or at office supply or crafting stores. For an extra luxe look, fine art paper may be used.

Important Note before getting started: When printing a file, confirm that the scaling option in the print preference box is set to "None." This is a vital step in ensuring the items print correctly.

PDF Viewer

To download a free PDF reader, go to <http://get.adobe.com/reader>

Now Let's Get Started!

Open the PDF and click print. The file is sized to print on 8.5" x 11" paper. Using the gray crop marks as a guide, cut out the two cards and fold each card in half. For a clean fold, use a scorer or bone folder. The folded cards are 4.25 x 5.5 inches and will fit in A2 sized envelopes.

Some Thoughts on Cutting

Use a paper cutter if available. Another option is to run an exacto knife along a sturdy ruler. If using scissors, or if you are nervous about your cutting skill, it may help to use a ruler to extend a light pencil line along the crop marks. Erase the line after cutting.
